MWHOA BOARD MEETING Tuesday, March 14, 2023 Via Zoom

The MWHOA meeting was held via Zoom and called to order at 7:07pm by President Maureen Serieux.

Approval of Minutes: The Annual Meeting minutes held on November 15, 2022 were presented for approval. Sundar motioned to approve the minutes with Maureen seconding. Motion was carried and approved unanimously.

It was noted the January 2023 Meeting was TABLED due to not having a quorum present.

Treasurer's Report and Approval: Sundar submitted the Balance Sheet and the Profit and Lost Reports as prepared by the bookkeeper through February 2023 along with the 2023 Budget. Sundar noted the Association was in good standing with account management and the assessment fees for 2023 would remain the same. AERC Report: It was noted that clean up was done within the common areas due to fallen trees. Also, due to a fallen tree was the repair to the fence of the drainage pond located behind the townhouses. Bulk pickup confirmed for May and October.

New Business: New signs were purchased and will be placed in all common areas regarding pet waste. A member noted issues with rats in area. It was noted pet waste on private homeowner's properties are not being properly disposed which attracts rats and issues with neighboring HOA's clean up.

A request was made to reach out to the neighboring HOA regarding their Pool area, removal of trash, bulk trash, and recyclable bins along townhomes on Centerway Road which affects the area appearance of each HOA.

Kathleen requested for the MWHOA Newsletter to include a reminder of keeping all trash and recyclable bins out of view after pickup day.
